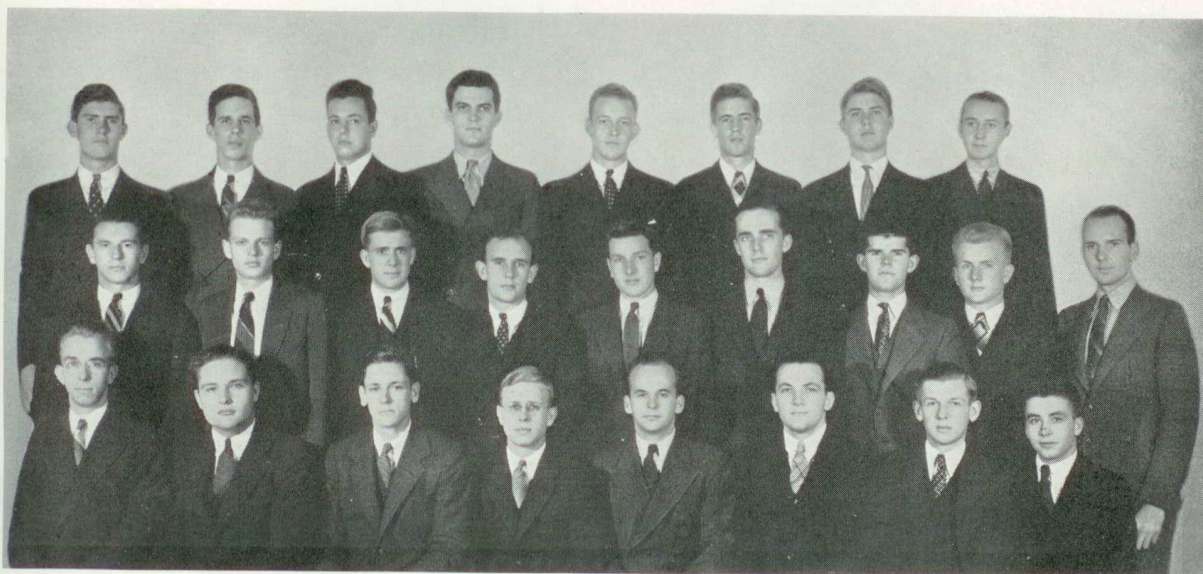

Theta Deuteron Charge



IDEALS of friendship held by six undergraduates of Union College, Schenectady, New York, crystallized into the Theta Delta Chi fraternity on October 31, 1847. A conservative policy in regard to expansion has always been maintained and charges have only been established at colleges which were most conducive to the fraternity spirit. Theta Delta Chi now has twenty-eight active charges.

In 1903 a number of Tech students organized a local fraternity, Alpha Epsilon. Being firmly oriented, the society petitioned for admission into the national organization. A charter was granted in June, 1906, and the members of Alpha Epsilon were initiated into Theta Delta Chi.

The fraternity moved to 80 Bay State Road in 1910 and from there to 334 Harvard Street in Cambridge in 1916. This house proved to be very pleasant, but by 1925 the house was seen to be inadequate and plans were made to secure a new one more convenient to the Institute. Thus in 1930 the charge moved to its present location at 314 Memorial Drive.
